Role Description

The Procurement and Strategic Sourcing team is part of the Supply Chain division and working very closely with the other two divisions in Supply Chain, Inventory and Warehouse/Logistic. The two main focuses on Procurement and Strategic Sourcing are to proactively partner with various business units to understand their materials and services and ensure the availability of material and services for the business.

As the Procurement and Strategic Sourcing Manager, you will provide leadership to Purchasing Agents and Buyers personnel, with the overall responsibility of sourcing and procuring material and services for Marine Atlantic's four vessels, two terminals and a few operational buildings in North Sydney (N.S), as well as in Port Aux Basques and St. Johns' (Newfoundland). You will be a part of the supply chain leadership team guiding Marine Atlantic in working collaboratively with internal stakeholders to understand their needs on the material and services. This will include but is not limited to developing the team's strategic sourcing and procurement capabilities, architecting robust category management to understand 80:20 spends and working with stakeholders throughout the organization to design an efficient contract and vendor management strategy.

Your responsibilities will include:

- Providing leadership in sourcing, procuring, contracting, categorizing and vendor lifecycle
 activities based on best practices and continuous improvement to meet Marine Atlantic's
 overall supply chain objectives
- Driving all procured material and services under contract within a certain period of time
- Supporting internal teams and internal stakeholders in implementation of SAP for Supply
 Chain Finance including training, process improvement and change management
- Working collaboratively with internal stakeholders to understand their needs on the material and services requirements
- Developing and managing strategic sourcing initiatives with internal stakeholders to drive down procurement costs based on the company's best interest and supporting long-term relationships with suppliers.
- Evaluating current purchasing and procurement processes to identify opportunities for improvement towards building a strong category management

- Partnering with the Inventory and Warehouse teams in evaluating sourcing, procurement and contracting strategy to identify opportunities in cost savings and cost avoidance for all inventory materials.
- Following relevant public accountability standards and remain consistent with legislation and trade agreements applicable to Marine Atlantic to develop, implement and manage Marine Atlantic's, contracting strategies across the organization for services and materials.
- Working closely with Legal, Risk, Safety and Finance to mitigate any financial risk and ensuring that appropriate systems and controls are in place
- Partnering with Legal and taking the lead in complex procurement including setting up criteria, working with the business units, selection process, contract negotiation and award; managing the active contract and contract close-out
- Working with the Director of Supply Chain to develop robust policies and procedures for procurement, strategic sourcing, contract management and vendor lifecycle
- Developing and implementing corrective action programs to ensure compliance with policies on all procurement activities
- Leading collaboration, process standardization and knowledge management activities across the sourcing, purchasing and contract life cycle to ensure all procurement activities are made based on Marine Atlantic's Supply Chain procedures
- Managing workload within the procurement team and coordinating cross functional assignments within the supply chain group as well as internal/external stakeholders
