Travel and Hospitality Disclosures

The Government of Canada implemented a series of measures to strengthen public sector management by enhancing transparency and oversight of public resources in the federal government.

As a federal Crown corporation, and in the spirit of these measures to promote openness, transparency and accountability, Marine Atlantic posts the travel and hospitality expenses of its Board of Directors and Executive Team through proactive disclosure on a monthly basis.

All expenses are inclusive of taxes. Please note there may be occasions whereby there is a delay in posting an expense due to timing of travel and processing of claims.

In March 2020, Marine Atlantic implemented a freeze on all non-essential corporate travel and discretionary training and also implemented additional approval processes for all essential travel as part of its response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The organization is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its employees and customers and to maintaining the vital ferry service linking the Island of Newfoundland to Nova Scotia. During the July to September 2021 quarter, the organization lifted the travel freeze and began conducting an evaluation of all requests based upon a combination of business requirements and public health protocols in place.
